Augmenting FCT with Chinese acupuncture and laser

Ken Andes (Practitioner and instructor of Korean acupuncture who is conducting a double-blind study on drug addiction, at present.)

This method, due to the simplicity of Korean acupuncture – one master point for each organ with the whole body topography confined just to a hand – seems quite straightforward to learn (at least in the mind of a simpleton like myself). Also, both the choice of the organ for therapy, and length of the needling are determined by the testing. The latter is crucial as over- and under-treatment in acupuncture are common mistakes with the former leading to aggravations, particularly in sick patients. The needle treatment may last as briefly as one minute and is combined with FCT sarcode for the key organ. Both the actual diagnosis and treatment right in the office consume a total of just several minutes with the results reported as quite impressive. Actual graphical and patient demonstration with their testimony will be presented.
